Come see these birds in nature!

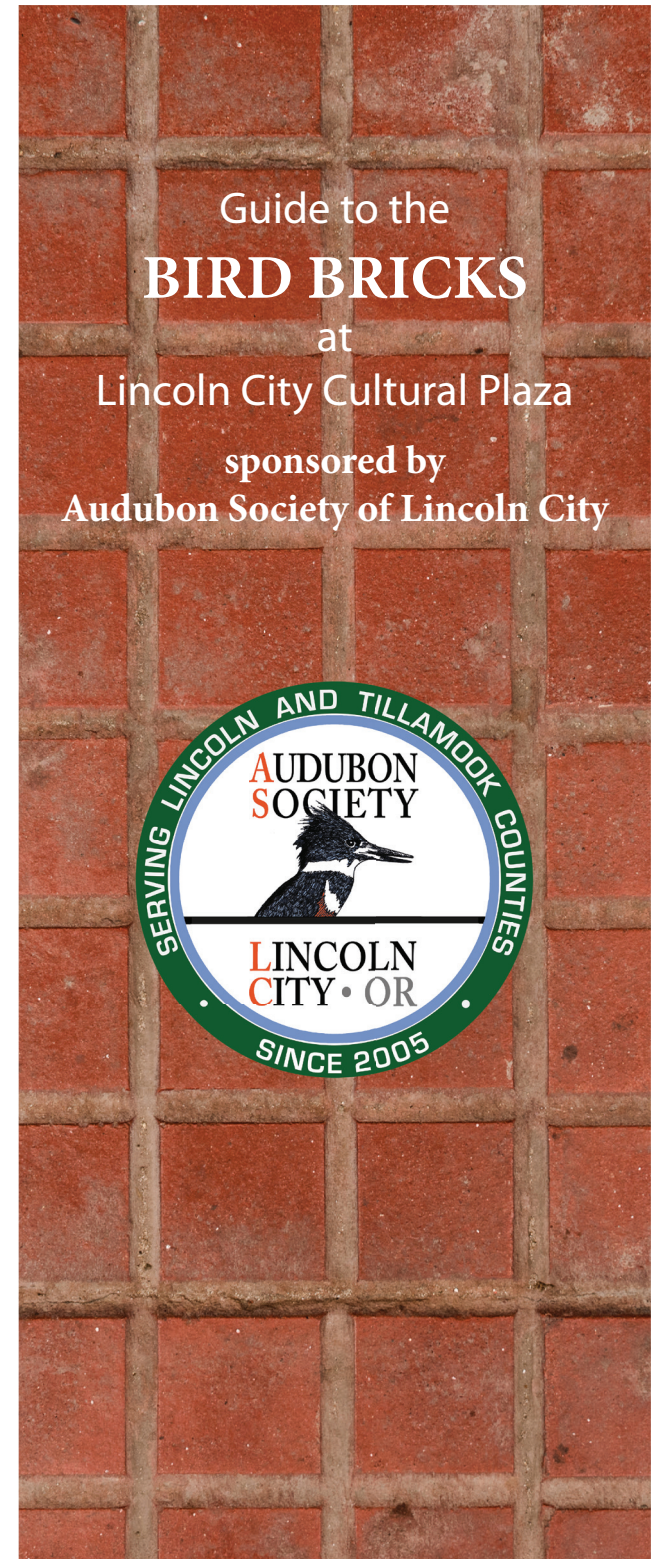
